

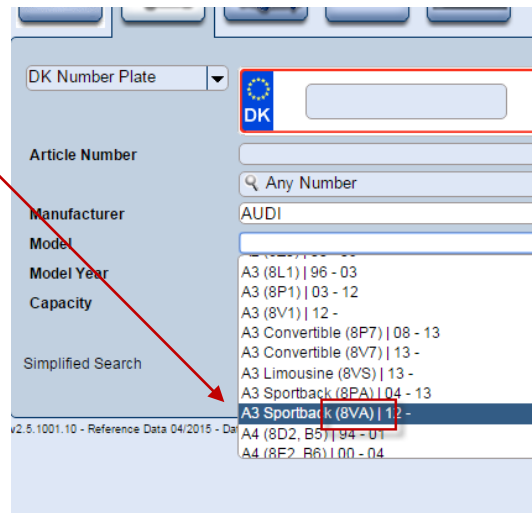
What?

Body code shows the exact vehicle generation, regardless of body type.

For example, Nissens only use A3/S3 (8V) (12-), while Tecdoc has A3 12-, A3 Convertible 13-, A3 Limousine 13- and A3 Sportback 12-.

Also notice that TecDoc shows a third number/letter which is an additional specification of the body type. We only show the generation.

8VA is Sportback body
8VS is Limousine body
8VZ is Convertible body
8V1 is 3 doors version body
Commonly called 8V generation.

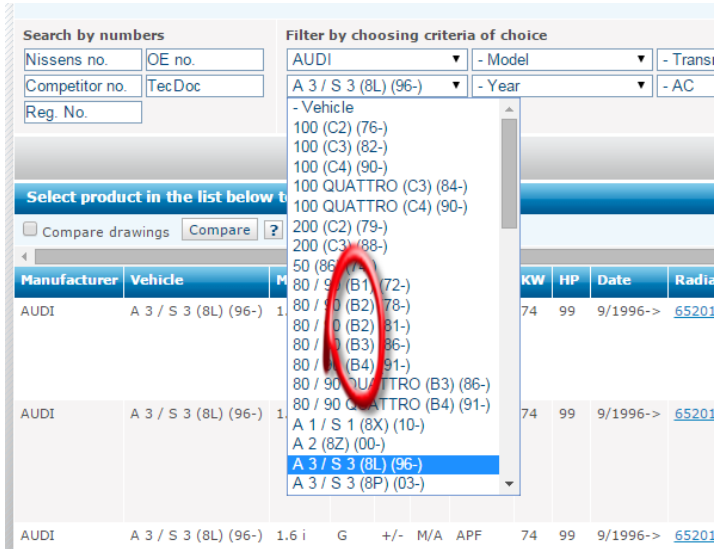
Body types

Why?

These different dates and body types can be confusing, mostly convertible and sedan overlapping.

With body code "8V" stated, the right generation will be showed and identified.

Where?



The first bracket always contains this new information, second bracket for model start date as before.

There are a few models where only numbers are shown, like on Audi 50 with body code "86" from 1974.
